



We inform you hereby that the **Legislative Decree no. 196 of June 30, 2003** (“**Personal Data protection Code**”) provides for the protection of persons and other entities regarding the processing of personal data. In compliance with the aforesaid regulation, your personal data shall be processed following principles of fairness, lawfulness and clarity in order to safeguard your privacy and your rights. The processing and communication of your personal data to third parties will be effected exclusively to fulfil the current dispositions of the law associated with the implementation of the contract.

The processing will be undertaken both manually and by computer.

We inform you that concerning the processing procedures, you may contact **JANOUSEK S.p.A.**, responsible for the data processing.

At any time you are entitled to exercise your right by making a request to the data controller in accordance with art. 7 of Legislative Decree no. 196 of June 30, 2003, as hereinafter specified in full for your convenience.

Art.7

Right of access to personal data and other rights

- 1) those concerned shall have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not the relevant personal data exist, regardless of their having been recorded yet or not, and communication of such data in intelligible form.
- 2) those concerned shall have the right to be informed:
 - a) of the source of the personal data;
 - b) of the purpose and methods of the processing;
 - c) of the logic applied to the processing, if the latter is carried out with the help of electronic means;
 - d) of the identity of the data controller, data processors and representative appointed for the purposes of art 5), paragraph 2;
 - e) of the entities or categories of entity to whom or which the personal data may be communicated and who or which may become aware of said data in their capacity as appointed representative(s) in the State's territory, data processor(s) or person(s) in charge of the processing.
- 3) those concerned shall have the right to obtain:
 - a) updating, correction or, where interested, integration of the data;
 - b) erasure, transformation into an anonymous form or blocking of data that have been processed unlawfully, including data whose storage is unnecessary for the purposes for which they have been collected or subsequently processed;
 - c) a certification to the effect that the operations under aforesaid letters a) and b) have been notified, as also relating to their content, to the entities to whom or which the data were communicated or distributed, unless this requirement is impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate effort with respect to the right that is to be protected.
- 4) those concerned shall have the right to object, in whole or in part:
 - a) on rightful grounds, to the processing of personal data concerning them, even when relevant to the purpose of the collection;
 - b) to the processing of personal data concerning them where this is carried out for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct sale or for market research or commercial promotion.
